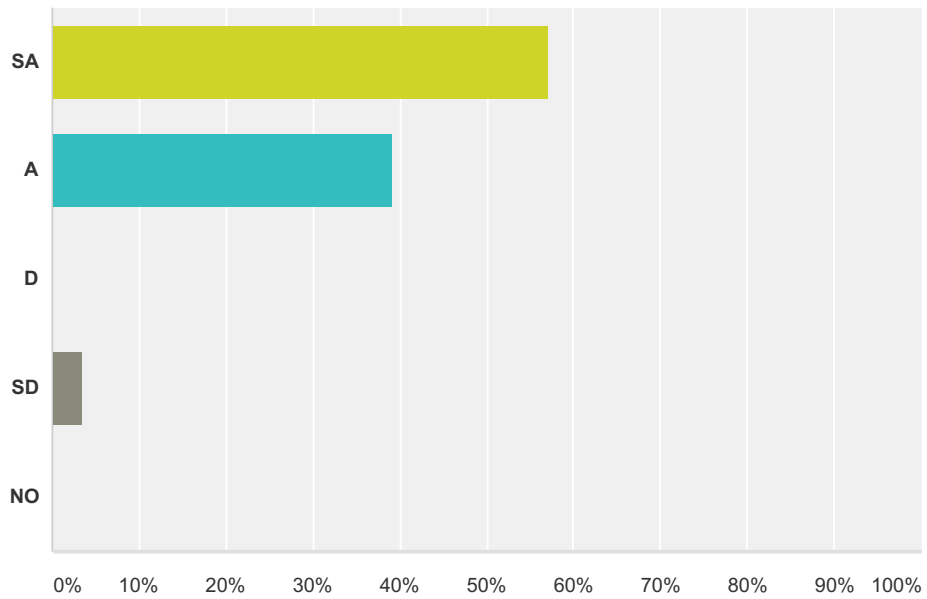
RESULTS

You will also find that some people are dissatisfied. Two issues that we have tried to address over the summer are:

- A more robust Wifi system has been installed at both campuses so that teachers and students will be better able to use the computer equipment we spent so much money on last year.
- We are offering more after school programs, especially at the North Campus for the lower grades. A chess club is being offered at both campuses and an engineering club at the North Campus for Grades 1-4. If these programs are successful, adjust clubs may be offered.
